but in their attempts to systematise our knowledge of forest biomass. In revising the original text I have attempted to maintain the input of Japanese work - much of which is not widely available outside Japan - and to update both the basic information and, where necessary, the conclusions to keep them in tune with current thinking. Those familiar with the Japanese original will find Chapter 3 largely rewritten on the basis of new work - much of which was initiated while Dr Satoo was in Blacksburg.

adottate. La trattazione si conclude con la descrizione delle due aree oggetto del progetto: Pratomagno e Monte Amiata e riporta caratteristiche e primi risultati relativi agli interventi di diradamento applicati. Del manuale sono state realizzate tre versioni linguistiche: italiano, inglese e spagnolo. Della versione italiana è stata realizzata anche una versione cartacea la cui distribuzione è prevista durante le attività di formazione e sensibilizzazione del progetto.
