1 they re the world s largest land animal the african savanna bush elephant is the world s largest land animal with adult males or bull elephants standing up to 3m high and weighing up to 6 000kg on average males only reach their full size at 35 40 years that s well over half their lifespan as wild elephants can live for up to 60 70 years

dwarf elephants are prehistoric members of the order proboscidea which through the process of allopatric speciation on islands evolved much smaller body sizes in comparison with their immediate ancestors dwarf elephants are an example of insular dwarfism the phenomenon whereby large terrestrial vertebrates that colonize islands evolve dwarf forms a phenomenon
